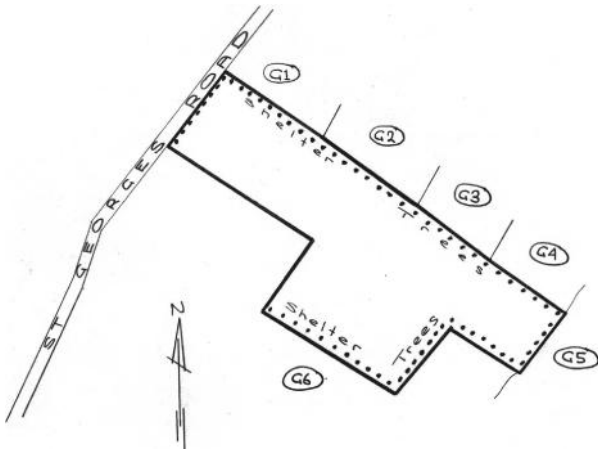

### Crops Sprayed

Apples and pome fruit crops are sprayed using Integrated Fruit Production (IFP) programmes and grown primarily for export markets. Spray application is ground applied using tractor driven airblast equipment. No aerial spraying is used.

### Hazard Management

<b>Accident Procedure</b>	Determine cause of event. Turn off or disengage equipment to make area safe. Assess nature of event. Evacuate if required. Advise emergency contact.

<b>Contamination Strategies</b>	Live shelter belts on roadside and affected boundaries are grown to a minimum of 3 meters high and evergreen. Roads are potentially used by children. Spray operators use best endeavours to spray boundary areas before 0800 and after 1600 hours where no shelter trees are present.
<b>Drift Hazard / Sensitive Areas</b>	Spraying not recommended during winds in excess of 10 km per hour. IFP programme avoids unnecessary spraying and low volatility chemicals are used by choice.
<b>Hazardous Agrichemicals</b>	Use of insecticides in accordance with label instructions. Agrichemicals are stored in secure areas on orchard property.
